## CO. LIMERICK MAN DIES IN COURT.

### Fatality at Rathkeale

Mr Henry J. Moran (53), married, draper, of Askeaton, Co. Limerick, collapsed in the chair on the witness box at Rathkeale District Court on Monday, while giving evidence before Mr Kenoy, D.J., in a motor accident case. He died shortly afterwards without regaining consciousness. Dr A. O'Sullivan and Canon Mangan, P.P., V.G., were called and attended deceased.

Adjourning the court without transacting any further business, the District Justice expressed sympathy with the relatives.

When the deceased had the seizure he was about to fall off the chair. He was saved from doing so by solicitors, who jumped over their desk and on to the witness box. The sad occurrence caused a painful shock in the court and town.
