

Newport Child's Death

A verdict that death was due to shock and toxemia, was returned at an inquest at Nenagh, on John Hart, aged 3, who received fatal scalds at his home at Ballinaheril, Newport, Co Tipperary. Mrs Hart, the mother said that after she had placed a gallon of hot water in a bucket 20 yards from her door, her daughter, Peggy (4), told deceased to put his leg in the water as he had not been washed that day. He did so, and the bucket overturned, scalding him.
