

Black and Tan War Recalled

Death of Limerick Doctor

The funeral took place at Abbey, Ballyorgan, of Dr M Fitzgerald, Martinstown, Kilfinane, Co. Limerick, who, during the Black and Tan War, was doctor to the East Limerick Brigade.

He attended, among others, Col. Liam Hayes, Adjutant-General, who was seriously wounded at Dromkeen ambush in 1920; Mr D Barry (now Secretary of the Irish Tourist Association) after the rescue of Sean Hogan at Knocklong; Mr D Breen, T D; Mr Sean Treacy and Mr E O'Brien.

The chief mourners were; Mrs M Roche and Miss E Fitzgerald (sisters), M Wallace, Miss M Wallace (cousins). Rev. J Carr, P P., officiated.
