

# Death of Prominent Citizen

## The Late Mr D O'Callaghan

The death occurred at St John's Hospital, Limerick, on Saturday, of Mr Daniel O'Callaghan. The deceased was a member of an old Limerick family of long connections with the commercial life of the city. He was managing director of Messrs E O'Callaghan and Sons, tanners, and chairman of the Federation of Irish Tanners. He was also a director of Limerick Shoes, Ltd. He was brother of the late Michael O'Callaghan, Mayor of Limerick in 1931, and his father, the late Mr E O'Callaghan, was also a former Mayor of Limerick. In early life the deceased practised in Limerick as a solicitor, and up to the time of the Treaty was Clerk of the Petty Sessions. He was a highly-esteemed and popular citizen, and deep sympathy is felt for his bereaved widow.
