Limerick, on Saturday, of Mr Daniel O'Callaghan. The deceased was a member of an old Limerick family of long counse. tions with the commercial life of the city. He was brother of the late Michael O'Callaghan, Mayor of Limerick in 1931, and his father, the late Mr E O'Collaghan, was also a former Mayor of Limerick. In early life the deceased practiced in Limerick as a solicitor, and up to the time of the Treaty was Clark of the Petty Sessions.
