Visitor's Tragic Death In Cork

A middle aged man, Charles Simmons, of Kilrush, county Clare, collapsed and died while walking near St. Finbarr's Cemetery, Cork, on Wednesday evening. He was removed to the Mercy Hospital, where life was pronounced extinct.

The deceased was an ex British Army man and served in the Great War. He had been staying in Cork on a holiday with Mr McMahon, 32 MacCurtain Buildings, a cousin of his, and at the time of the tragedy was out walking with a relative. He leaves a wife and family who reside near Kilrush.
