

Farmer's Death

Tragic County Limerick Affair

On Tuesday evening Dr John Clery, Coroner, held an inquest with a jury touching the death of Michael Ryan, farmer, 46, of Thomastown, Kilmallock, which took place that morning.

After hearing the evidence, the jury returned a verdict to the effect that death was due to gunshot wounds, self-inflicted, whilst temporarily insane.

The Coroner tendered sympathy to the relatives of deceased.

Mr D Walsh, foreman of the jury, joined in the expression of sympathy, as did Inspector Lavar, Bruff, who represented the State.
