The funeral of the late Mr A M De Prins, whose death took place on Tuesday night at his residence 8 Barrington street, Limerick, took place on Thursday to Mt. St. Lawrence Cemetery. Born in Limerick of French parents, deceased was for many years French Consul in Limerick, and was on more than one occasion complimented by the French Government for the manner in which he discharged his duties. For half a century he was a member of Garryowen R.F.C., holding the position of President, and was for many years Hon. Treas. to the club. He was also a Past President of the Munster Branch I.R.F.U. He was in his younger days a keen cricketer, and was one of the founders of the Catholic Institute Club. The soul of courtesy, the deceased was a very pleasant companion, and enjoyed the friendship of a very large circle. The funeral was attended by the Mayor (Ald. D Bourke, T.D), and a large and representative concourse of the citizens.
