
Farmer's Death

County Limerick Inquest

Dr J P Cleary, coroner for East Limerick, held an inquest at the Co Hospital, Creem, into the circumstances of the death of Daniel Ousack, Kilbredean, Shanagolden, county Limerick, who died in the institution a few hours after admission with throat injuries.

A jury was sworn, of which Mr D B O'Donnell was foreman.

Supt J J Cooney, Adare, represented the Garda authorities.

After evidence of identification was given,

Dr J M Quinlan, House Surgeon, Co Hospital, gave evidence of the nature of the wounds which led to the man's death.

It was stated deceased was a farmer residing alone, and was unmarried, and was in failing health for some time.

A verdict was returned that death was due to throat wounds self inflicted while of unsound mind following ill health.
