Death of Rev A Canon Clancy

The death occurred at the Parochial House, Killaloe, of Very Rev A Canon Clancy, P.P., V.C., Killaloe. Deceased, who had only been ill for a short time, was a fervent Gaelic League enthusiast, and a supporter of the Land League. He was ordained in Paris in 1880 and was 88 years of age. He served as a curate in Killinier, being transferred to Ballynacally as parish priest, and afterwards as Professor of St Flannan's College, Ennis.

The oldest member of the Cathedral Chapter, he was appointed to Killaloe in 1921. He was a brother of the late Very Rev James Clancy P.P., Toomevara, and a firm friend of Mr T.W. Cosgrave, T.D.

The remains were removed to Killaloe Church on Wednesday evening and the funeral took place on Thursday after Solemn Office and High Mass.
