

Death of Mr B Murray

A Popular Sportsman

The death occurred at his residence, Portland, Limerick, on Sunday, of Mr Bruce Murray, chairman of Messrs Wm Todd and Co, Limerick. The deceased gentleman was a well known figure in rowing circles in Ireland, being the oldest member of the Limerick Boat Club, of which he was President up to the time of his death. Mr Murray was in his younger days an outstanding oarsman, and never subsequently lost his interest in the sport. Although he had reached the advanced age of 86 years, up to quite recent times he was to be seen on the river in the capacity of coxswain to the Limerick Boat Club crews, almost every evening during the season, and his experience and direction was invaluable to aspiring young oarsmen.

The funeral took place this morning from the Presbyterian Church, Henry St., to St Mary's Cathedral, and was representative of the professional and commercial community of the city.
