Death of Mrs. E. Crowe

It is with the most sincere regret that we announce the death of Mrs Emily Crowe, relict of the late Mr Timothy Crowe, victualler, Sarsfield street, Limerick, which occurred at Milford House Convalescent Home, on Monday.

Deceased lady was an extremely popular figure in the National life of Limerick for many years. She was a member of the Limerick Corporation and its subsidiary bodies in the popular interest during the Anglo-Irish war, and during the East Clare election of 1917 she entertained many of the Republican leaders at Truagh Castle where she and her family then resided.

The remains will be removed this (Tuesday) evening from Milford to St Michael's Church at 7.30 p.m. Requiem High Mass for the repose of the deceased's soul will be offered up to-morrow (Wednesday), after which the funeral will take place to Meant St Lawrence Cemetery.
