## Canon Ryan Passes Away

At the Parochial House the death took place of Very Rev Michael Canon Ryan P.P., Knocklong. Born in 1857 in Upperchurch Parish, county Tipperary, the late Canon Ryan was educated at St Patrick's College, Thurles, where he was ordained in 1886. After his ordination he administered in Westminster Diocese, where he was presented with a gold watch for services rendered who had aided in numerous church matters. Subsequently he moved for 11 years to Adm. in Thurles Cathedral, after which he came to Knocklong as parish priest in July, 1924, and later made a Canon of the Diocese of Cloyne. A priest beloved by his people, he led a very busy life.
