

Drowning Fatality

Boy Loses His Life in R.S.B. Canal

A drowning fatality in which Patrick Monaghan, 18, only son of Mr P Monaghan, postman, Clonlara, county Clare, lost his life, occurred in the new canal at Clonlara, on Sunday. It appears that young Monaghan, in company with another youth named Daffy, were fishing from a barge moored to a jetty on the canal. He went to retrieve his rod, which had fallen, and tumbled overboard. The body was found about an hour afterwards under the barge.
