

Drowning Fatality

Boy Loses His Life In R.S.B. Canal

A drowning fatality in which Patrick Monaghan, 16, only son of Mr P Monaghan, postman, Cloonsa, county Clare, lost his life, occurred in the new canal at Cloonsa, on Friday. It appears that young Monaghan, in company with another youth named Duffy, were fishing from a barge moored to a jetty on the canal. He went to retrieve his rod, which had fallen, and drowned overboard. The body was found about an hour afterwards under the barge.
