

Drowned In Ballybunion

County Man's Fate

Patrick Kelly, 19, Sugarhill, Templeglantine, county Limerick, was drowned while bathing at Ballybunion on Thursday, and two other bathers—Rev Father Galvin, an American priest, and Richard Nash, Newcastle West—rescued with difficulty.

Shouts from one of the bathers were answered by Michael Dalton, Dick Daly, of Charles street, Listowel, and John Walsh, of Market street, who went to the rescue with a lifebony. Fr Galvin was placed in the lifebony, but the float broke and he was brought ashore with difficulty.

Desmond Bell and Jeremiah Danaher, visitors at Ballybunion, succeeded in rescuing Nash, but Kelly had already disappeared and his body was recovered later.

The deceased was on a caravaning holiday at Ballybunion with Nash.
