

Limerick Doctor's Death

Dr Edward Danden, Horris, who died at the Richmond Hospital, Dublin, was a native of Co. Limerick. He qualified some 40 years ago, and after being house surgeon at the Richmond was in practice in Horris for many years. Prominently associated with Sinn Féin, he was imprisoned for his political activities in 1916. Later he was identified with Fine Gael, and contested the Wexford constituency in the 1933 election.
