Sad Limerick Fatality

On Friday night last a sad fatal accident occurred at Lisnagry railway level crossing, whereby Mrs Margaret O'Carroll, a middle-aged widow, lost her life. Deceased was employed by the G.S.R as gate-keeper, and about 1/2 8 o'clock along with her daughter she was engaged in opening the gates for the passage of a goods train during a thick fog when she met her death in a crash as the second side of the gate was being opened.
