## Death of Mrs Mary Liston

Mrs Mary Liston, Lisnisky, Newcastle West, county Limerick, whose death took place on Saturday, came from a family prominent in the national movement.

Her husband, the late Mr James B Liston, was advocating the Irish freedom cause on Limerick public bodies even before the days of Sinn Fein and all of the family were in the forefront of the Anglo-Irish conflict.

One son, Jim, was a Commandant in the First Southern Division, and served under the late General Liam Lynch in many of the major engagements.

During both the "Tan" war and the Civil war the farmhouse at Lisnisky sheltered many of those "on the run," and was the scene of frequent military raids.

Other sons prominent in the ranks of the First Southern Division were, the late Dan Liston and Maurice Liston, a member of the editorial staff of the "Irish Press."

Rev. Mother Bernadette, Sacred Heart Academy, Sarigo, U.S.A., is another member of the family.

The funeral will take place to-day from Knockaderry Church to Drihidtrasna.
