OBITUARY

MR. C. FOLEY, REEN'S PIKE.

The death occurred on Friday morning of last week of Mr. Cornelius Foley, merchant, Reens Pike, Rathkeale. Deceased, who came from a highly-esteemed and widely-respected West Limerick family, carried on a lucrative general and licensed business at the well-known junction on the main Rathkeale-Newcastle West road, and his fine personality endeared him to all. As a breeder and trainer of high-class greyhounds he was a popular figure at most of the coursing and track meetings in the city and county. Two of his sons, Michael and Patrick, were leading members of the Rathkeale senior hurling team, and another son, Con, was prominently identified with a well-known Club in Dublin, where he has been employed for some years. Although he had not been in the best of health for some time past, the late Mr. Foley was up and about as usual the evening before his demise and his passing with such tragic suddenness came as a great shock to a wide circle of relatives and friends. There was an exceptionally large and representative attendance at the funeral, which took place from Coolcappa Church to Rathkeale Cemetery on Saturday.

Rev. Father Fitzgerald, P.P., Kilmoleman, officiated at the graveside, and the clergy in attendance included:—Rev. Father Murphy, P.P., Croagh; Rev. M. O'Brien, P.P., Castlemahon.
