

Death of Mr E. Leahy, Sol.

The death occurred at St John's Hospital, Limerick, after an illness of some weeks duration, of Mr E. Leahy, solicitor, Limerick. Deceased, like his father before him, was a prominent legal practitioner in the city, and, in addition, he farmed in an extensive way. He was a keen sportsman, in his younger days sporting the colours of Limerick Boat Club in many a hard won race. He bred and raced, both on the track and in the open, some first class greyhounds. He was a keen lover of the 'show', and for many years "Old" Leahy, as he was very popularly known, acted as Secretary to the Limerick County Horse Club for a number of years.
