

Ennis Labourer's Death

Inquest Adjourned

The inquest on Wm Scales (70) Clare Road, Ennis, married, a general labourer, who died from injuries in the Co Hospital, was adjourned on the application of Supt P H Casey pending instructions from the Attorney General.

His son James said he was in his home when a man called him and said his father had been knocked down by a motor cycle. His father's sight was all right but he had been a little deaf.

Dr J B McClancy, County Surgeon, said Scales's injuries included a compound fracture of the left knee joint. He had a cataract in his left eye which witness thought had been completely blind. Death was due to shock caused by the injuries, which were consistent with his having been knocked down by a motor cycle.
