Recalls Black and Tan Days

The death has occurred of Mrs Mary Moloney, Ballyhahill, county Limerick, a well known member of a popular West Limerick family. She was the mother of the late Major Thomas Moloney, Irish Air Force, who met his death tragically in 1926 as the result of an air crash while on manoeuvres in Kildare; and of Miss Mary Moloney, nurse, Limerick Hospital.

During the fight for independence Mrs Moloney's house always afforded a safe asylum for men "on the run."

There was a large and representative attendance at the removal of the remains to Ballyhahill church and at the funeral the following day to Killorglin Cemetery. Rev M Ryan, p.p., Ballyhahill, said the prayers at the graveside assisted by Rev J McDoane, S.C., Ballyhahill.
