County Lady's Death

Recalls Black and Tan Days

The death has occurred of Mrs Mary Moloney, Ballyhabill, county Limerick, a well known member of a popular West Limerick family. She was the mother of the late Major Thomas Moloney, Irish Air Force, who met his death tragically in 1936 as the result of an air crash while on manoeuvres in Kildare; and of Miss Mary Moloney, nurse, Crown Hospital.

During the fight for independence Mrs Moloney's home always afforded a safe asylum for men "on the run."

There was a large and representative attendance at the removal of the remains to Ballyhabill church and at the funeral the following day to Killeogus Cemetery. Rev M Ryan, P. P. Ballyhabill, read the prayers at the grave site, assisted by Rev J McDonnell, O. C., Ballyhabill.
