## Man's Death at Ballyneety

A tragic discovery was made at Ballyneety, county Limerick, where the dead body of a foreman carpenter was found lying beside a bicycle close to the doorstep of a house in the village. The dead man was identified as Patrick O'Donoghue, 41, of Adare, where he had resided with his wife and two children. For some time he had been in lodgings near Ballyneety in connection with his work as foreman for the Board of Works.

The sad discovery was made by a farmer on his way to Limerick market at about 6.30 a.m. The guards were notified immediately and the body was subsequently removed to the courthouse nearby where an inquest was held by Dr P. J. Clery, East Limerick Coroner.

A verdict was returned of heart failure, after evidence had been given that deceased had visited Limerick on the previous day and apparently had a seizure on the way back to his lodgings.
