Death of Fr. Keogh, P.P.

Loss to Cashel Archdiocese

The death occurred on Monday at the Presbytery, Annacarty, Co. Tipperary, of Very Rev Fr Wm. Keogh, P.P.

One of the best known priests in the Archdiocese of Cashel, he was the son of Mr Cornelius Keogh, Ballybrood, Cahereonlish, and was aged about 65. Educated at Rockwell and St Patrick's College, Maynooth, he was ordained in Maynooth in 1901, and went to Glasgow for a period. Later he served as curate in several parishes in Cashel, including Solohead and Marree, before being appointed P.P. at Annacarty in 1934. During his time as pastor there he renovated churches and schools. He was a brother of the late Dr Keogh, Dunderam; Mrs Bree, Cashel, and Mrs Gleeson, Nenagh, and uncle of Rev Father Keogh, Cullen; Rev Sister M Baptist, Doon; Rev Sister M Gabriel, Nenagh; and Rev Sister M Aquinas, Ennis.
