

Death of Mr M Cagney, Croom

The death of Mr M Cagney, Bridge street Croom, has occasioned widespread regret and sorrow not alone in county Limerick but in the adjoining counties, where he was a well known and highly respected figure. He was brother of, Rev Bro. Cassin, Presentation Order, Mardyke House, Cork, to whom and the bereaved family and a large circle of relatives much sympathy is extended in their loss.

Following the removal of the remains to St Mary's parish church, Croom, the funeral took place on the following day to the family burial ground at Shanavegga.
