

Trap Turns Over

Sad Tragedy

Limerick Lady's Death

A very sad tragedy, in which a very well known and highly esteemed Limerick lady, Mrs Winifred Casey, wife of Mr John Casey, poultryer, Roche's street, lost her life, occurred at Knockan Cross, near Newmarket on Fergus, on Monday morning.

It would appear that Mrs Casey, with her husband, left Limerick on Sunday in a pony and trap to visit her sister, Mrs Gubbins, Cashin, Newmarket on Fergus. They were returning home on Monday morning when, as a result of one of the wheels rolling over a stone or bank, the trap overturned at Knockan Cross and the occupants were thrown on to the road, Mrs Casey receiving injuries which proved fatal about half an hour later. Mr Casey, it is understood, received only minor injuries.
