

Boy Drowned At Foynes

Bernard Graham Jones (13), Nenagh, who was on holiday at Foynes with relatives, was to have returned home on Saturday. On Friday he went for a final bathe and had been in the water only a short time when he got into difficulties. His aunt Mrs Little, who is a non swimmer, entered the water but her efforts were unsuccessful. The body was later recovered by Garda McCormack. Mr Cussen, Newcastle West, Coroner, recorded a verdict of death from drowning.
