

# Fall From a Bicycle

## Garda Sergeant's Death In Clare

When returning to the Garda Barracks at Doolin, county Clare, after midnight on Saturday, Sergeant James Murray (48) fell off his bicycle and was rendered unconscious by an injury to his head. He remained on the roadside for about eight hours before being discovered by a workman and was then removed to Clare Co. Hospital, where he died without regaining consciousness. He was an old I.R.A. man, unmarried and was a native of Courtbrock, Blarney, co. Cork. All his service was spent in Clare.

A verdict of accidental death was returned at the inquest and the remains, in a Trilobite-dugout coffin, were removed by road to Courtbrock, Blarney.
