
Killaloe Woman's Death

Inquest Verdict

A verdict of suicide while temporarily insane was returned by the jury at the inquest on Mrs Mary Donnellan (61) Cross Road, Killaloe, who was missing from her home since September 23. The body was recovered from the Shannon. Medical evidence was given that the deceased had been suffering from sore leg. Death was due to drowning. A juror drew attention to the unprotected banks of the canal and said that a gate should be erected where the fatality occurred. A diver had been employed in the search for the body.
