

Death of Canon O'Carroll

Very Rev Michael J Canon O'Carroll, r r, Ollis, who died suddenly on Monday at his residence, was born in the parish of Oeanagh in 1862. On Sunday he celebrated Mass at Ollis Parish Church. Subsequent to his appointment as curate in Patrickswell, he served as curate in Ballyhabill, Kilmallock and Colemanwell. He was appointed Parish Priest of Stonchall in 1917, and the following year was appointed P.P. of Ballyhabill. He was transferred to Ollis in 1927.

Both he and the late Canon Fitzgerald were educated together at Mungret College. They went to Rome together, where they were both ordained on the same day in 1886. They spent some years together on the English Mission in the Diocese of Westminster. Both were recalled to the Limerick diocese at the same time, and their first appointments were as curates at Patrickswell.
