

Death of Limerick Composer.

It is with feelings of the most sincere regret that we record the death, which took place at the Richmond Hospital, Dublin, on Friday last, of Mr Francis Earle, compositor, Thomondgate, a well-known and highly-respected member of the Limerick Typographical Society for over 40 years. An able craftsman, deceased was ill for only a few weeks, and the news of his death in Dublin, whither he had gone for treatment, came as a great shock to his many friends. A sincere friend and a most agreeable companion, deceased was ever of a most straightforward and manly disposition.
