

Another Remand

County Murder Charge

At Fermoy Court on Monday, John O'Donoghue (25), single, of Knockamane, appeared again in the dock on a charge that at Knockamane, near Kilbeheny, co. Limerick, between 27th and 28th June, 1943, he did with malice aforethought unlawfully kill and murder one Mary Moher.

Supt J Moore, Fermoy, in reply to Mr D Casey, State Solr, said that he had already made a deposition. He was making further inquiries and he expected to connect the accused with the crime. He applied for a further remand for eight days or sooner.

Mr E Finn, solr, who appeared for the accused, asked that the hearing be at Mitchelstown in order to facilitate the witnesses.

The Justice (Mr G Farrell) granted the remand and fixed the next hearing for Mitchelstown on Monday next at 12 noon.
