

Death of Mr. James O'Donovan

It is with feelings of the most sincere regret that we announce the death of Mr James O'Donovan, which took place at his residence, Crescent Villas, O'Connell Avenue, after a rather protracted illness. Deceased, who was a member of a very old and highly respected West Limerick family, was a native of Robertstown, Foynee.
