

# Adjourned Inquest

## Limerick Soldier's Death

At the resumed inquest on Private Bartholomew Hennessy, a native of Limerick city, who was killed as a result of a Bren carrier overturning on the Endicough road and pinning him underneath, the verdict of a coroner's jury at Basis was that he died from shock and hemorrhage and that a contributory factor to the accident had been inefficient lights on the carrier. Evidence was given that the carrier had only one light on the right-hand side—"a soiled, black-out light"—which rendered it difficult for the driver to see the road.
