

County Limerick Inquest

A verdict in accordance with the medical evidence, that death was due to a fracture of the base of the skull, was returned at the inquest held by Dr John P Cleary, Coroner, Hospital, on James Healy (15), Corbally, Knocklong, who died as a result of injuries sustained when he fell from a cart near Knocklong. It appears that the boy, who was standing on the cart, fell backwards when the animal suddenly stopped. After the fall he proceeded to Knocklong and transacted some business, but died after returning home.
