## Passer Away In A Lorry

When driving in a best lorry from Benagh to Cashel on Monday to attend a seed bestgrowers' meeting there Mr John Seymonr (60), Monses, Nenagh, had a seizure near the village of Burnsoleigh and expired in a few minutes.

In the early stages of the seigure Mr deprious at empired to get out of the lorry such the driver, in a fruitless attempt to teep uton search, had to relinquish his hold on the attesting wheel of the lorry which prashed against a ditch, the cab becoming disconnected from the chassis.

The late Mr Beymour was chairman of the Council of the Beetgrowers' Association and chairman of the Thurles Board of Beetgrovers. A member of the North Tipperary committee of Agriculture and a keen promoter of local and inter-county ploughing matches, he farmed extensively and was one of the most prominent figures in the egricultural life of North Tipperary.
