The incidence of tuberculosis is particularly high among the poorer classes, a circumstance that is due to certain social and economic factors. To enumerate a few of these we need only mention bad housing, insufficient nourishing food, insanitary conditions and the absence of proper care and treatment at the incipient stage of the disease. It is hardly necessary to say that patients placed under any of these categories cannot hope to battle successfully unaided against the insidious and treacherous attacks of the "white scourge." It is imperative, therefore that immediate help should be forthcoming, no matter what the cost or the initial difficulties to be overcome. Above all, there should be no ques-


