Died While Ploughing ?

Two brothers, Martin and John Ahern, (farmers), Mountpelier, O'Briensbridge, County Limerick, were working together in their gardens preparing for the sowing of spring crops, the latter ploughing the land. About midday Martin went home to bring John his lunch. When he returned he observed the horses and plough stationary on the headland. On investigation he discovered his brother lying dead across the plough. Dr Fitzmaurice, M.O., Castleconnell, stated that death was due to over exertion and deemed an inquest unnecessary. The deceased was 46 years old.
