

Limerick Solicitor's Death

Passing of Mr J. D. Ryan, L.L.B.

It is with sincere regret that we announce the death of Mr John D. Ryan, LL. B., solicitor, which occurred on Saturday last. The late Mr Ryan, who resided at India Villa, Corbally, was son of the late Mr Timothy Ryan, an ex Mayor of Limerick, and had built up a lucrative practice since his admission as a solicitor sixteen years ago. Deceased, who was ill for only a brief period, was a very popular figure in the city. He had marked literary traits, and some years ago was a regular contributor in verse and prose to the columns of the Echo under the nom-de-plume, 'James Corbally'. He leaves a widow and two children to mourn his loss, to whom the sympathy of the citizens is extended unstintedly in their very sad bereavement.
