## Young Man's Death

A very sad fatality occurred in the city shortly after midnight on Monday morning by which a very popular young citizen, William Lee, aged 33, of Corporation Buildings, lost his life. It appears that deceased slipped when descending the stairs at his home and fell heavily, fracturing the base of the skull. He lapsed into unconsciousness, and was subsequently taken to Barrington's Hospital where he died a few hours after admission. The deceased was a clerk in the Limerick Employment Exchange, and sincere sympathy is expressed with his wife and two young children in their tragic bereavement.

An inquest was held at Barrington's Hospital to-day by the Deputy City Coroner, Mr J S McNeill, solr, when a verdict in accordance with the medical evidence, that deceased died from a fracture of the base of the skull, was returned, and sympathy tendered to the widow and relatives in their bereavement.
