## Death of Mr J. C. Browner

The death took place at his residence, Adelaide Road, Dublin, on Monday, of Mr J C Browner, the well-known operatic singer. Aged about 60, "Jay C" first sprang into the limelight when he won the Feis Ceoil Gold Medal as a baritone in 1904. He quickly established a big reputation on the concert platform before taking up singing professionally. He toured with the Carl Rosa, O'Mara and other opera companies, singing all the principal baritone and bass roles. Probably he was at his best as "Mephistopheles in Gounod's "Faust." He is survived by his wife, four daughters and a son. The last-named is a singer of promise, having won the Gold medal for bass solo singing at this year's Feis Ceoil. The late Mr Browner was well known in Cork, Limerick and Waterford.
