Limerickman's Sad End

A verdict of death from heart failure was recorded at an inquest in Waterford on Monday on Timothy M Windle (45), 12 Bailey's New Street, Waterford, who collapsed, and died in a few minutes in a hide and skin store at O'Connell Street, Waterford. Deceased, who was a commercial traveller, was formerly manager of Messrs K and J Dicks boot warehouse in Waterford, which has been closed for some years past. The evidence was that Windle walked into the store from the street, and sat on the steps leading to the office, where he was discovered in an unconscious condition by a clerk named John Rogers. Deceased, who was a native of Limerick, leaves a widow and six children.
