Limerick P.P.'s Death

Sincere regret will be caused by the death which occurred at the Parochial House, Knockaineey, Co Limerick, of the Very Rev A Canon Humphreys, P.P. The deceased priest, who was 75 years of age, celebrated the Golden Jubilee of his Ordination to the priesthood last year. A native of Murroe Co Limerick, he was educated at the Irish College, Paris. Before coming as P.P. to Knockaineey, Canon Humphreys served as curate in Knockloog and Emly. He is a brother of Dr Frank Humphreys, T.D., Dr Joseph Humphreys, Rossmadda; Dr A Humphreys, R.M.O., City Home and Hospital; Sister Margaret, a member of the Presentation Order, Balingarry, Co. Tipperary; Mr Tim Humphreys, Ranelagh, Dublin; Mr James Humphreys, Murroe, and another brother the late Rev John Humphreys, C.C., who pre-deceased him some 10 years ago, was another distinguished member of the clergy of the archdiocese.

The funeral obsequies took place to-day after Office and Solemn Requiem Mass.
