

Popular Sportman's Death

The Late Mr John Kelly

The death occurred at his residence, Ballinacurra, Limerick, on Monday, of Mr John Kelly, former principal of Monaleen National School. Deceased, who reached an advanced age, took a deep interest in athletics from his youth, and for half a century was a prominent figure in the national sporting arena. He was chairman of Limerick County Board G A A thirty years ago, and for a period was chairman of the Munster Council. N A and C A. His work on behalf of both organisations in their early years was productive of much good in developing and propagating Gaelic athletics. Deceased was father of Rev M Kelly, C.C., Newcastlewest; Rev Peadar Kelly, O.A.S.P., and of Sister Mary Ita and Sister Mary Lelia, Holy Rosary Community.
