# Bicycle Collision Has Fatal Results

---

A fatal sequel to a bicycle collision in which Jeremiah Hayes, aged 80, was involved was investigated by Coroner Dr O'Leary at Croom Hospital on Saturday. It was stated that while Hayes was cycling from Ballingarry to Rathkeale on the 19th October he came into collision with a pony and trap. He was removed to the Croom Hospital where he subsequently died from the injuries received. After hearing evidence of identification, etc, the inquest was adjourned.

Supt. Cobney, Adair, on behalf of the Authorities; Mr M Twomey, foreman of the jury; Dr Cooke and the Coroner tendered sympathy to the relatives.
