Death of Mr Manning Robertson

The death occurred at his home, 10 Ragian Road, Dublin, on Saturday, March 17. of Manning Robertson, FRIBA, the well known architect and town planning authority. Mr Manning Robertson was educated at Eton and Oxford was articled to the late Sir Ernest George RA, and was Deputy Chief Architect to the Honsing Department of the British Ministry of Health for many years. In 1925 he came to Ireland and established a practice here as an architect and Town Planning Consultant He was Town Planning Consultant for Cork.; Limerick, Dun Laoghaire, and collaborated with Sir Patrick Abercrombie and Sedney Kelly on the Dublin sketch plan, Howes first chairman of the Irish branch of the Town Panning Institute. He also made the akeeches recent'y in connection with proposed street improvements in Cork city.
