Death of Mr Patrick Belton, Ex-T.D.

The death occurred in Dublin this moraing in his 60th year of Mr Patrick Balton, ex T.D. Deceased was a native of Laucaboro, County Lengford, and in his younger days was in the British Civil Service in London, where he helped to found Sinn Fein. He returned to Ireland to an appointment in the Irieh Land Commission, and later fought in the Easter Rising in 1916, being subsequently imprisoned for He was elected to the Dail as a Figure Fail Deputy in 1927 for Dublin County, during the period when that Party did not take their seats He resigned from Figure Fail, and entered the Dail, being defeated at the subsequent General Elec-In 1933 he was re elected as a Cumana na Gaedheal Deputy. In 1928 he was elected as an Independent Deputy. and remained in office until 1943. He was a member of the Irish Christian Front in the Spanish Civil War. A man of won-derful activity, he was an extensive farmer and building contractor, being responsible for the huge building scheme of subarban houses in Dublin known as Belton Park. He was a member of the Dublin Corpora tion and the Dublin County Council and of the Governing Body of the National University, etc, etc.
