
Death of Mr M Hartigan, Croom

The death has occurred of Mr Martin Hartigan, Bellview, Croom, at a comparatively early age. Deceased was an excellent judge of livestock and carried on on a large scale the business of breeding cattle with renowned success. He was particularly interested in the breeding and rearing of in-calf heifers and beef, and the success which attended him in this sphere farming life was widely known and recognised, his cattle of these classes being much in demand. He was very popular in the district, and though his death was not entirely unexpected, it evoked widespread sympathy. Following Requiem Mass at Banogue Church, his interment took place in Fedamore, and the large congregation, representative of all classes, that was present at the graveside evinced the high esteem in which the deceased was held.
